


# School-based AFL Academy Launching in 2026

We will be launching a specialist AFL Academy Classes at Years 9 and 10 in 2026.






# AFL Academy Classes Classes at Year 9 and 10 in 2026


Multiple fitness and strength testing throughout the year






### Proposed Uniform

### Player Code of Ethics and Conduct

Our values and expectations for academic endeavour teamwork, participation, behaviour, and respect are of the highest standard. At all times I will uphold the Glenroy College school expectations of Integrity, Respect, Teamwork and Achievement.

### Player Code of Ethics and Conduct Agreement

As a Glenroy College AFL Academy member, I agree to abide by and follow the rules of the academy listed below:

- I will arrive at classes, training, games, events and/or destinations on time and be prepared. I understand that it is my responsibility to have all of my
  equipment needed ready for training, games and/or events, this includes uniform, drink bottle and my own playing equipment.
- I will never be violent or bully others at school, home, on the sports field or in the wider community. I am committed to stopping violence and abuse
  when I see it in all forms.
- I will bring a note to excuse myself from training if I have an injury, I will come prepared with other work to do during class time. If the injury persists,
  I will see a medical professional to determine what course of action is required to rehabilitate.
- If I am unable to make training for any reason, I will give my coaches at least 24 hours' notice with a legitimate reason.
- I will refrain from the use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco products or weapons of any kind while I am a representative of Glenroy College AFL Academy
- I understand that my behaviour reflects on my school, teammates, coaches, and Glenroy College AFL Academy as a whole. I will always be on my best behaviour at training, games, in the classroom (all subjects), other team events and in the general community.
- I will always ensure that my uniform is correct, clean and I will always be presentable in public. I will respect the AFL Academy uniform and the jersey.
   My uniform is my own, it is not to be leant to others, particularly those outside of the Glenroy College AFL Academy.
- I will approach the Academy teachers for guidance with any issues that may be inhibiting me to participate to my best ability.
- I will respect my teachers, coaches and/or leaders at all times, and listen carefully to their instructions. I understand that they are giving their time to
  make me a better student, player, and athlete. When I do not understand I will ask questions in an appropriate, respectful manner.
- I will support and respect my teammates, opponents, and officials always. I will not tease, ridicule, put down or make fun of any players on my team or the opposing team, at any time.
- I will always show good sportsmanship, both when winning and losing. I will always congratulate the other teams and wish them well.
- I am committed to developing as a student and sportsperson. This includes attending practices, listening to my teachers, coaches and/or leaders of Glenroy College AFL Academy, and always giving my best effort.
- I understand that being a student athlete, I am a student first. I commit to achieve my absolute best results in the classroom and during assessments.
   This means finding a balance between school, AFL, and life. I am willing to ask for support with this to be the best I can be.
